HOW TO QUICK GROOVE.



 Put the Driver carefully into the Quick Groove.



2. Lift the Driver up to loosen the Tone-Ring.

QUICK-TIPS

- · The mouthpiece cushion protects the mouthpiece. Please do not remove it.
- The Tone-Rings do not need grease or any kind of oil.
- · Always use the thickest Tone-Ring on top.
- Insert the mouthpiece centered into the barrel. It needs to fit airtight.
- The reed has to be exactly centered and should end at the top of the mouthpiece.
 When the reed fits correctly, tighten the ligature, using only a small amount of pressure.
- · If the blowing-resistance is too high/low, move the reed very slightly down/up.

QUICK-TIPS

- Clean and dry your mouthpiece after using it.
- · Use a sensitive disinfectant if necessary.
- Wipe off the reed with a cleaning cloth, do not rub or use too much pressure. Pull the cleaning cloth straight and along the bore, always from bottom to top.
- Correct maintenance is very important.
 Incorrect cleaning may damage your mouthpiece.
- · The best depository is your MAXTON box.
